Dear Colleagues in the Community,

The Latino Hope Foundation is pleased to announce the 4th annual Fiesta Spokane Heritage Festival on Saturday, September 30, 2017 from 11am to 8pm. Due to construction on Post, this year's family friendly event will be hosted on Wall Street on the block between Spokane Falls Boulevard and Main Street. As always, the event will feature delicious food, entertainment, vendors, community organizations, a health fair, and lots to do for the kids! Everyone is welcome!

We are currently accepting reservations for product vendors, food vendors, corporate vendors and community organizations for this fantastic event. Please get your reservations in as soon as possible as space is limited.

Product/service vendors, corporate vendors and community organizations may reserve space from 11am-8pm. The cost includes a 6-foot table and two chairs. [Vendors and organizations will need to bring their own table coverings and tents, if desired.] The festival goes from 11am until 8pm, and product vendors and community organizations may begin setting up as early as 10am.

A section of the venue will be available for food vendors to sell food and beverages. Each vendor will be permitted to sell non-alcoholic beverages along with food. We are charging a flat fee of \$200 for food vendors for the day. The festival goes from 11am until 8pm, and food vendors may begin setting up after 10am.

The Festival typically follows the annual Latino Hope Foundation 5K Run/Walk, however, due to construction, this year's race has been cancelled.
